- 40. "The Trustees may apply an annual sum not exceeding £100 in apprenticing with Premiums, "not exceeding £20 each, poor children to some honest trade or calling."
- 41. "Any child, being the Son or Daughter of an Inhabitant of the City of Rochester, or the limits, "liberties or precincts thereof, shall be eligible to be so apprenticed; but the Trustees
 - "shall in all cases give a preference to those Boys or Girls who shall have distinguished themselves by their aptitude for learning, diligence, or good conduct in any Public
 - "Elementary School, as defined by the Education Act, 1902, within the City of Rochester,
 - "or the limits, liberties, or precincts thereof; and for the purpose of encouraging the Children of such Schools, the Government Inspector of the Schools shall be requested by
 - "the Trustees to report to them after every examination of the School, the names of such
 - "Scholars as he may think most deserving of this reward, and the Trustees shall also
 - " request the Managers of all such Schools to report to them the names of any Scholars who

"may have particularly distinguished themselves by their good conduct."

The Trustees will not award any Premium for Apprenticing a Child to to his or own parents; nor for Apprenticing a Child under 14 years of age; nor for Apprenticing a Child already bound Apprentice.
