Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 1st. May, I am directed to inform you that the Commissioners consider that in the circumstances the Kent County Council may be allowed to use the Almshouses (with the exception of the parts required by the Trustees) as a rest centre; but the Council should be responsible for any damage not being war damage to the property and should pay the rates and other outgoings. In the event of the Almshouses being required for occupation by the Almspeople the Trustees should be able to resume possession.
